

ProNAi Therapeutics Files Registration Statement for Proposed Initial Public Offering

Vancouver, BC – June 12, 2015. ProNAi Therapeutics, Inc., a clinical-stage oncology company pioneering a novel class of therapeutics based on its proprietary DNAi technology platform, today announced that it has publicly filed a registration statement on Form S-1 with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) relating to a proposed initial public offering of its common stock. All shares of common stock to be sold in the offering will be offered by ProNAi. The number of shares to be offered and the price range for the proposed offering have not yet been determined. ProNAi intends to list its common stock on the NASDAQ Global Market under the ticker symbol "DNAI."

Jefferies LLC and BofA Merrill Lynch are acting as joint book-running managers for the proposed offering. BofA Merrill Lynch is also serving as ProNAi's strategic IPO advisor. Wedbush PacGrow and SunTrust Robinson Humphrey are acting as co-managers.

This offering will be made only by means of a prospectus.
